Our Food Processing Cluster



Our food processing cluster is substantial, consider the following:



- We have over 4,000 people employed in the sector in the labor shed
- We have seen a 36% job growth in Soft Drink Manufacturing job growth from 2011-2016
- Food service contractors have seen 87% job growth from 2011-2016
- We are above the US average in the number of companies in our labor shed by the following percents:
 - 9 times more Dried and Condensed Evaporated Dairy Product
 - 5 times more Bottled Water Manufacturing
 - 2 times more Soft Drink Manufacturing
 - 2 times more Ice Manufacturing
- We have over 14,000 people employed in transportation & logistics in the labor shed

- The University of Tennessee and Virginia Tech have a Department of Food Science and Technology which provides many advantages for labor and research for food companies

Colleges/Universities with Food Processing Programs

- University of Tennessee in Knoxville has an enrollment of 27,171 and is located 98 miles from Sullivan County
 - The University of Tennessee has a Food Science and Technology program which offers undergraduate and graduate degrees, research, and an extension program
 - This program offers access to a packaging and processing pilot plant, among other resources ranging from financial assistance to food safety regulatory assistance



- Virginia Tech University in Blacksburg, Virginia has an enrollment of 29,684 and is located 125 miles from Sullivan County
- Virginia Tech University has a Food Science and Technology program which offers undergraduate and graduate degrees, research, and an extension program
- This programs offer access to a packaging and processing pilot plant, among other resources ranging from financial assistance to food safety regulatory assistance
- Virginia Tech's Department of Human Nutrition, Foods and Exercise routinely works hand-in hand with Food Sciences and Technology to jointly address issues on nutritional value and product development/packaging



- Northeast State Community College is located in Blountville, with regional campuses in Kingsport and Bristol
- Northeast State Community College is beginning a Culinary Arts program within the next year
- Northeast State Community College has ample space to train your workforce in their RCAM (Regional Center for Advanced Manufacturing) by way of recruiting, screening, and customized training

Construction Costs

- According to RSMeans Construction Cost Data, Sullivan County is less expensive than the following:
 - \$22/sq. ft. less than the US average to build a manufacturing facility and \$16/sq. ft. less to build a warehouse
 - \$9/sq. ft. less to build a manufacturing facility than in Nashville and \$6/sq. ft. less to build a warehouse than in Nashville

- \$11/sq. ft. less to build a manufacturing facility than in Atlanta and \$8/sq. ft. less to build a warehouse than in Atlanta
- \$13/sq. ft. less to build a manufacturing facility than in Lexington, Kentucky and \$10/sq. ft. less to build a warehouse than in Lexington, Kentucky
- \$15/sq. ft. less to build a manufacturing facility than in Cincinnati, Ohio, and \$11/sq. ft. less to build a warehouse than in Cincinnati, Ohio

Low Natural Disaster Risk

- According to usa.com, Sullivan County has a 34.60 Tornado Index which is much lower than the US average of 136.45 and Tennessee's average of 175.35
- According to usa.com, Sullivan County has a 0.16 Earthquake Index compared to a US average of 1.81.
