Tri-Cities Climate



Surrounded by the Appalachian Mountains, Tri-Cities temperatures tend to be relatively mild year-round with an average July high temp of 84.8 and an average January low of 24.7. Rainfall averages less than 44 inches per year and sunshine is present 60% of the time. The risk of tornado activity is significantly below the Tennessee state average, and is 6.5 times below the overall U.S. average.

Tri-Cities Education

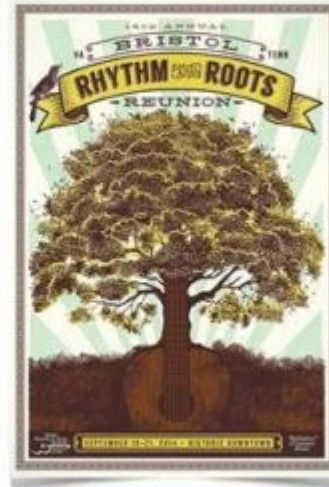
A regional center for higher education, Tri-Cities is home to many colleges and universities, with a total regional enrollment of more than 67,000 students.
